





Jim Jackson Foundation Funding Available - speak to your Personal Development Coach

Jim Jackson Foundation. The Jim Jackson Educational and Enabling Foundation

- 1. Purpose: Supports young people (16-24) in supporting their business-based career ideas, especially those facing obstacles.
- 2. Target Group: Disadvantaged, talented individuals recommended colleges, social workers, and community institutions.

Support Offered

- 1. Funding: For students with excellent attendance, behaviour, and passion for their subject.
- 2. Types of Support:
 - 1. Training and development opportunities.
 - 2. Assistance with business-related expenses (e.g., trip costs, tech, extra training).
 - 3. Support for apprenticeships and work placements.

Application Process

- 1. Form Submission: Students complete an interest form here. https://forms.office.com/e/me603hYZGL register interest before May 2025.
- 2. Meeting: Students meet with the Bursary Officer to discuss their needs in detail and how the foundation may help.
- 3. Decision: The foundation reviews the applications sent from the College and decides on financial assistance.

Outcome

1. Goal: Enable young people to succeed in a future business-based idea and give back to their community.
